Policy paper and Recommendations for integrating cultural diversity in higher education

HE4u2 - Integrating Cultural Diversity in Higher Education intends to make teaching and learning in HE more diverse, responsive and competitive by integrating inclusive pedagogies into existing curricula. This can mediate obstacles for learners from migrant and culturally diverse backgrounds and value their contribution to the intercultural dimension for all learners.

HE4u2 responds to the needs of HE staff involved at different levels with culturally diverse students, offering a set of Guidelines and a Continuing Professional Development course which equip them with skills to create an authentic intercultural space, offer appropriate mentoring and support specific learners in their individual and group needs.

Based on the awareness that cultural diversity and its integration in the day-to-day life of higher education institutions should be understood and reflected in policies at higher level, the project consortium decided to embed the policy dimension in all the project phases, leading to the development of a policy paper and recommendations.

HE4u2 has analysed what is offered already at university level and what is needed at policy level and will present a proposal for integrating these issues top-down in Brussels. Policy makers and other key stakeholders are invited to participate in this half a day event on Thursday 26 April 2018, starting at 09:00CET.
